

Resolution 2018-03
Surplus Vehicle/Asset Deletion/Parks and Waterways

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and,

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the County under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-808 provides that property classified as being valued under \$250.00 may be sold through a private sale without notice of public auction; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Parks & Waterways Department desires to dispose of one (1) 1985 International Pickup Truck, asset tag #3349; VIN # 1HTDLUYP9FHA10472, which has outlived its useful life for the Parks and Waterways Department and is of no further use to the County; and

WHEREAS, the vehicle described hereinabove is in poor condition and has a value of less than of \$250.00, but would generate income to the County via a sale; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Parks and Waterways Department desires to have the above-referenced item declared as surplus property, disposed of pursuant to law, and removed from the County's asset list;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the item referenced hereinabove be, and hereby is, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said item by public or private sale, or by another means, in accordance with Idaho law and remove the same from the County's list of assets.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Bingham, seconded by Commissioner Fillios, the following vote was recorded:

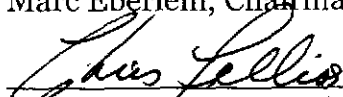

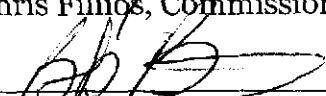

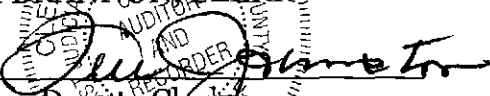
