WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners received a request for reduction of the 2017 taxes on the above referenced parcel number, record owner being David and Marilyn Chance, 3540 E. 1st Ave., Post Falls, Idaho 83854; and

WHEREAS, David and Marilyn Chance requested the reduction of the 2017 taxes to reflect the Circuit Breaker on the referenced parcel as they had purchased a new home in 2017 and the property tax relief credit was erroneously applied to the former parcel; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners on April 4, 2018 at a properly noticed public meeting, agreed to adjust the taxes for 2017 to reflect the circuit breaker received in 2016;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED that the taxes for the 2017 tax year be adjusted to reflect the circuit breaker received in 2016; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Treasurer and Assessor be directed to take appropriate action to effectuate said Resolution.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Bingham, seconded by Commissioner Fillios, the following vote was recorded:



Upon said roll call, the text of the foregoing was duly enacted as a Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Kootenai County on the 4th day of April, 2018.




