

**Resolution 2018-78**

**Non-Capital Asset Deletion/Auditor's Office/Information Technology**

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai County Auditor's Office has on its Non-Capital Asset list (Exhibit "A") items which are duplicated on the Non-Capital Asset list for the Information Technology Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai County Auditor's Office desires to have the Non-Capital Asset items listed on Exhibit "A" removed from their asset list;

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the items referenced hereinabove, are removed from the Auditor's list of Non-Capital Assets; and

**FURTHER**, that the assets listed on Exhibit "A" be maintained by the Information Technology Department.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Bingham, seconded by Commissioner Fillios, the following vote was recorded:


