

Resolution 2018-80
Surplus Equipment/Asset Deletion/Juvenile Detention

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the County, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-808 provides that property valued at less than \$250.00 may be sold through a private sale without notice of public auction; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Juvenile Detention Department has in its possession, to-wit: one (1) Dayton Floor Buffer, Asset tag #1254 as identified on Exhibit "A" attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the item of equipment as identified above is currently not usable and, due to age and present condition, is unrepairable, obsolete and/or fully depreciated and has outlived its usefulness to the County; and

WHEREAS, the estimated value of the equipment is less than \$250.00; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Juvenile Detention Department desires to have the above-referenced equipment declared as surplus, disposed of pursuant to law, and removed from the County's asset list;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the equipment item referenced hereinabove be, and hereby is, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said item by public or private sale, or by another means, in accordance with Idaho law and remove the same from the County's list of assets.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Fillios, seconded by Commissioner Bingham, the following vote was recorded:




