

Resolution 2018-75
Surplus Vehicle/Asset Deletion/Community Development

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the County under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-808 provides that property classified as being valued under \$250.00 may be sold through a private sale without notice of public auction; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Community Development Department desires to dispose of one (1) 2002 Dodge Dakota pickup, asset tag#3419; VIN #1B7GG16X025587828, which has outlived its useful life for the Community Development Department and is of no further use to the County; and

WHEREAS, the vehicle described hereinabove has a value in excess of \$250.00; and

WHEREAS, the sale of the vehicle would generate additional income for the County; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Community Development Department desires to have the above referenced vehicle declared as surplus property, and as such, to be disposed of by the County at public auction;


NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the vehicle described hereinabove be, and hereby is, declared to be surplus property, and, in accordance therewith, said vehicles shall be sold at public auction to the highest bidder in accordance with *Idaho Code* 31-808.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Fillios, and seconded by Commissioner Bingham, the following vote was recorded:




