

Resolution 2018-77
Capital Asset Deletion/Auditor's Office/Information Technology

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Auditor's Office has on its Capital Asset list (Exhibit "A") items which are duplicated on the Capital Asset list for the Information Technology Department; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Auditor's Office desires to have the Capital Asset items listed on Exhibit "A" removed from their asset list;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the items referenced hereinabove, are removed from the Auditor's list of Capital Assets; and

FURTHER, that the assets listed on Exhibit "A" be maintained by the Information Technology Department.


