

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-17
EXCHANGE OR TRADE-IN OF PERSONAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his jurisdiction or control which, in his judgment is obsolete, worn or damaged so as to require replacement and is of greater value on a trade-in or exchange for replacements than upon the sale as above permitted, he may, incident to purchase of such replacements and with the consent of the board of county commissioners, trade in or exchange such personal property and apply its trade-in or exchange value on the purchase price of replacements;

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Assessor's Office Office has in its possession two (2) vehicles, to-wit:

- (1) 2000 Chevrolet Blazer VIN #1GNNDT13WXY2362438
- (1) 2001 Chevrolet Blazer VIN #1GNNDT13W012147673

These vehicles are presently being utilized by Assessor's Office personnel;

WHEREAS, the two (2) vehicles described hereinabove have outlived their usefulness to the Kootenai County Assessor's Office due to costs for upkeep and repair in order to maintain the vehicles in a safe, reliable, and useful condition;

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Assessor's Office desires to use the two (2) vehicles described hereinabove as trade-ins for the purchase of two (2) new vehicles, in that said vehicles have a greater value on trade-in than upon auction and/or private sale;

WHEREAS, Parker Ford has offered to take the two (2) vehicles described hereinabove as trade-ins towards the purchase of one (1) 2018 Ford Explorer, Sport Utility 4x4 and one (1) Ford 2018 Escape, Sport Utility 4x4; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of County Commissioners consent to the trade-in of the two (2) vehicles described hereinabove.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Kootenai County Assessor's Office is hereby authorized to use the two (2) vehicles identified above as trade-ins for the purchase of one (1) 2018 Ford Explorer, Sport Utility 4x4 and one (1) 2018 Ford Escape, Sport Utility 4x4 from Parker Ford; and

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Bingham, and seconded by Commissioner Fillios, the following vote was recorded:




