

**Resolution 2017-26**  
**Surplus Vehicle and Asset Deletion/Prosecuting Attorney's Office**

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and,

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai Prosecuting Attorney's Office has on its asset list and in its possession a 1995 Pontiac Grand Prix, VIN #1G2WJ52MoSF271066, License #C17511, Asset #3169, which has outlived its useful life for the Prosecuting Attorney's Office; and,

**WHEREAS**, the vehicle is in poor shape and has high mileage due to its age, and it would not be cost effective for Kootenai County to maintain said vehicle; and,

**WHEREAS**, the vehicle has a value of approximately \$800.00, and/or may have some value insofar as it can be sold for scrap; and

**WHEREAS**, the sale of the vehicle outright or for scrap could possibly generate income for the County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai County Prosecuting Attorney desires to have the vehicle declared as surplus property, deleted from the asset list, and sold outright or for scrap, or otherwise be disposed of by the County.

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the vehicle described hereinabove be, and hereby is, removed from the County's list of assets and declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, said vehicle shall be disposed of by public sale, or by other means, in accordance with Idaho law.


Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Bingham, seconded by Commissioner Fillios, the following vote was recorded:
