

**Resolution 2017-45**  
**Surplus Vehicle/Asset Deletions/Buildings & Grounds**

**WHEREAS**, Idaho Code §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County, and

**WHEREAS**, Idaho Code §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai County Buildings & Grounds Department has on its asset list one (1) 1993 GMC 1/2 ton pickup truck, Asset #2102; VIN # 1GTDC14Z6PE544166 which due to age and safety concerns has outlived its usefulness to the county; and

**WHEREAS**, the vehicle is in poor condition and not worth the cost of repair; and

**WHEREAS**, Kootenai County Buildings & Grounds desires to have the above referenced item declared as surplus property and disposed of pursuant to law;

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the item referenced hereinabove be, and hereby is, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said item by public or private sale, or by another means, in accordance with Idaho law.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Bingham, seconded by Commissioner Fillios, the following vote was recorded:


