

Resolution 2017-36
Consent to Annexation into the City of Athol

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners (hereinafter referred to as "the Board"), pursuant to Idaho Code §31-806, is authorized to hold, maintain, improve, and operate property it has acquired for the use and purpose of a public park or public recreation; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County owns certain public trail property, commonly known as Farragut Trail, located along Highway 95, which property's Parcel Number is 53N03W-10-6600 and AIN is 181220; and

WHEREAS, HJ Grathol, a California general partnership, owns certain adjoining property on the eastern boundary of Kootenai County's Farragut Trail property and on the western boundary of the Highway 95 right-of way, which property's Parcel Number is 53N03W-10-5000 and AIN is 121649; and

WHEREAS, HJ Grathol seeks annexation into the City of Athol pursuant to Idaho Code §50-222, and therefore requests the County's consent pursuant to Idaho Code §50-222(4); and

WHEREAS, the annexation is sought for property lying within the area of city impact and which is, or upon annexation will be, contiguous to the City of Athol.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that Kootenai County, through its Board of Commissioners, hereby consents to the annexation by the City of Athol of the Farragut Trail property.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Fillios, seconded by Commissioner Bingham, the following vote was recorded:




