

Resolution 2017-41

Kootenai County Sheriff/Peace Officer and Detention Deputy Protection

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §67-5340 provides certain protection for employees of the State who are categorized as peace officers and detention deputies and who are physically disabled by a serious injury or illness arising out of their duties; and,

WHEREAS, out of respect and appreciation for those that protect us each day, Kootenai County wishes to afford the same protection to our peace officers, detention deputies and animal control officers; and,

WHEREAS, Kootenai County also feels that this protection should be extended to peace officers, detention deputies and animal control officers who become injured or physically disabled as a result of performing an official act in the course of their duties;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that Kootenai County adopts, with the above extension, the provisions of *Idaho Code* §67-5340 for like-employed County employees, effective April 11, 2017.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall supersede and repeal Resolution 1994-48 and any other previously enacted resolution pertaining to the same subject matter, and shall be effective as of the date of signature below.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Fillios, and seconded by Commissioner Eberlein, the following vote was recorded:




