

**Resolution 2017-67**  
**Surplus Weapons and Asset Deletion/District Court--Bailiff**

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County, and

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-808 provides that property not exceeding \$250.00 in value may be sold at private sale without notice or public auction; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai County District Court/Bailiff's Office has in its possession (8) eight 9mm Beretta Pistols, serial numbers BER363203Z; BER374470Z; BER342650Z; BER342648Z; BER342643Z; BER342647Z; BER044107; and BER342644Z, which due to age have outlived their useful life for the County; and

**WHEREAS**, each of the pistols described hereinabove has a value not exceeding \$250.00 and would be of no benefit to other County Departments; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai County District Court/Bailiff's Office desires to have the above-referenced property declared as surplus property, disposed of pursuant to law, and removed from the County's list of assets;

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the items described hereinabove be, and hereby are, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said items by public or private sale, or by other means, in accordance with Idaho law, and remove the same from the County's list of assets.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Bingham, seconded by Commissioner Fillios, the following vote was recorded:


