

**Resolution 2017-85**

**Purchase of Goods and Services on the Open Market/Parks & Waterways**

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §67-2805(2) sets forth the procurement procedures applicable to the purchase of public works construction valued in excess of \$200,000.00 via competitive sealed bid process; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai County Parks and Waterways Department sought to procure the construction and installation of new public docks at Mowry Park pursuant to *Idaho Code* §67-2805(2)(a) by soliciting competitive sealed bids in Bid No. 2017-15; and

**WHEREAS**, the sold bid received in response to the Bid No. 2017-15 solicitation was significantly higher than the cost estimated and said bid was rejected by the Board of County Commissioners at the public Business Meeting on or about September 5, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §67-2805(2)(a)(viii) authorizes the Board of Commissioners, in its discretion, to find that a project sought to be accomplished by the expenditure can be performed more economically by purchasing goods and services on the open market, and to adopt a Resolution declaring the same; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners hereby finds that purchasing the goods and services for the public works construction and installation of a new public dock at Mowry Park can be performed more economically on the open market;

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the Kootenai County Parks and Waterways Department be, and hereby is, declared to be authorized to purchase the goods and services for the public works construction and installation of a new public dock at Mowry Park on the open market.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Bingham, seconded by Commissioner Fillios, the following vote was recorded:




