

**Resolution 2017-88**  
**Destroy Records/Medical Records/Miscellaneous Records/KCSO**

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-871 states that county records may only be destroyed by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners; and

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-871 requires the resolution ordering the destruction and disposition of county records to list, in detail, records to be destroyed; and

**WHEREAS**, an audit of certain county records in the possession of the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office, Custody Division, have been performed and legal service having been sought and given regarding the disposal of said records;

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the files previously classified as permanent records by Resolution 2017-87 shall be done under the direction and supervision of the Kootenai County Sheriff.


Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Bingham, and seconded by Commissioner Fillios, the following vote was recorded:
