

Resolution 2016-21
Destroy Records/Assessor

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-871 states that county records may only be destroyed by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, an audit of certain county records has been performed and legal advice regarding the disposal of these records has been received; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-871 requires the resolution ordering destruction and disposition of county records to list, in detail, records to be destroyed; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the records of the Kootenai County Assessor's Office included in "Exhibit A" attached, previously classified in Resolution 2016-20 are authorized to be destroyed.

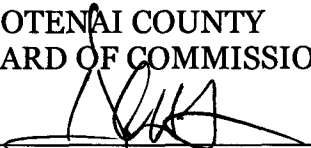

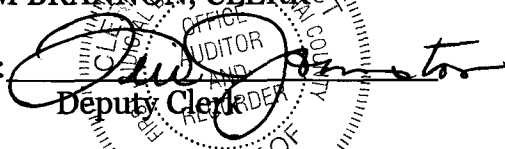
