

Resolution 2016-27
Surplus Property/District Court/Bailiff

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-808 provides that property classified as being under \$250.00 may be sold through a private sale without notice of public auction; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County District Court/Bailiff's Office has in its possession two (2) metal foot lockers, which have outlived their usefulness to the County; and

WHEREAS, the two metal foot lockers described hereinabove have a value less than \$250.00 or have no value whatsoever, and therefore would be of no benefit to other County Departments; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 allows elected officials to declare unused and unwanted county property as surplus and dispose of the same through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County District Court/Bailiff's Office desires to have the above referenced property declared as surplus property and disposed of at the County's direction;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the property described above is declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said property by public or private sale, or to dispose of the property as they see fit, in accordance with Idaho law.


Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Eberlein, seconded by Commissioner Green, the following vote was recorded:






