

**RESOLUTION NO. 2016-71**  
**Authorizing Accelerated Building Permit Procedures to Remedy**  
**Windstorm Damage and Establishing Permit Fee**

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners adopted Resolution No. 2015-94, with an effective date of November 19, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2015-94 was to sunset on May 19, 2016, one hundred eighty-two (182) days after its effective date; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that it is necessary and in the public interest to extend the terms of Resolution No. 2015-94 for another one hundred eighty-two (182) days in order to provide the Director of Community Development with continued authorization to implement accelerated building permit procedures to more efficiently issue building permits for work necessary to remedy damage to structures actually or proximately caused by the windstorm occurring on or about November 17, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the fee for building permits issued for work necessary to remedy damage to structures actually or proximately caused by the windstorm should continue to be a flat fee of \$100.00;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the terms of Resolution No. 2015-94 shall be extended for one hundred eighty-two (182) days retroactive to May 19, 2016.


Upon a motion to adopt the foregoing Resolution, made by Commissioner Stewart, and seconded by Commissioner Eberlein, the following vote was recorded:


