

**Resolution 2016-75
Destroy Records/KCSO**

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-871 states that county records may only be destroyed by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-871 requires the resolution ordering the destruction and disposition of county records to list, in detail, records to be destroyed; and

WHEREAS, an audit of certain county records in the possession of the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office, having been performed and legal advice having been sought and given regarding the disposal of said records;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the records of the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office attached as "Exhibit A" and incorporated into Resolution 2016-74 adopted on June 14, 2016 are authorized to be destroyed.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Eberlein, seconded by Commissioner Green, the following vote was recorded:




