

Resolution 2016-81
Asset Deletion/District Court

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-808 provides that property classified as being under \$250.00 may be sold through a private sale without notice of public auction; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County District Court has on its asset list various items identified in the attached Exhibit "A;" these items are obsolete due to age, or are inoperable and non-repairable, and/or have previously been disposed of, and are therefore of no further use to the County; and

WHEREAS, the estimated present value of each item is less than \$250.00, being previously disposed of and/or essentially valueless; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County District Court desires to have the above-referenced items removed from the County's asset list; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the items referenced hereinabove are valueless, obsolete and/or lost and shall be removed from the County's list of assets.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Stewart, seconded by Commissioner Eberlein, the following vote was recorded:

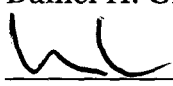

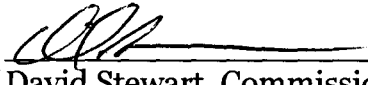
