

**Resolution 2016-87
Destroy Records/KCSO/9-1-1**

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §31-871 states that county records may only be destroyed by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §31-871 requires the resolution ordering the destruction and disposition of county records to list, in detail, records to be destroyed; and

WHEREAS, an audit of certain county records in the possession of the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office, 9-1-1 Division, having been performed and legal advice having been sought and given regarding the disposal of said records;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the training records of past employees and reel to reel dispatch recording tapes previously classified as temporary records by Resolution 2016-86 shall be destroyed under the direction and supervision of the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office.


Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Stewart, and seconded by Commissioner Green, the following vote was recorded:


