

Resolution 2016-88
Surplus Equipment/Juvenile Detention

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County, and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-808 provides that property classified as being worth under \$250.00 may be sold through a private sale without notice of public auction; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County Juvenile Detention has on its asset list one (1) Buffer, Asset tag #1255 and one (1) Security Camera System, Asset tag #4309, which, due to age are no longer functioning and therefore of no further use to the County; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County Juvenile Detention desires to have the items removed from the County's asset list;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the items referenced hereinabove, are valueless, obsolete and shall be removed from the County's list of assets.


Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Stewart, seconded by Commissioner Green, the following vote was recorded:

Chairman Green:	Aye


