

**Resolution 2016-103**

**Surplus Equipment and Asset Deletion/Parks and Waterways Department**

**WHEREAS**, Idaho Code §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

**WHEREAS**, Idaho Code §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

**WHEREAS**, Idaho Code §31-808 provides that property classified as being worth less than \$250.00 may be sold through a private sale without notice of public auction; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai County Parks and Waterways Department has on its asset list two (2) Sanisailor pumpout systems identified in detail in the attached Exhibit "A;" these items are obsolete due to age, or are inoperable and non-repairable, and/or have previously been disposed of, and are therefore of no further use to the County; and

**WHEREAS**, the estimated present value of each item is less than \$250.00, having been previously disposed of and/or being essentially valueless; and

**WHEREAS**, Kootenai County Parks and Waterways Department desires to have the items identified in Exhibit "A" declared as surplus property, disposed of pursuant to law, and removed from the County's asset list; and

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the items referenced hereinabove be, and hereby are, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said items in accordance with Idaho law and remove the same from the County's list of assets.
