

Resolution 2016-97
Acceptance of Donation of Two Arctic Cat Bearcats for
Kootenai County Sheriff's Office

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to receive real and personal property in donation, and to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, Frontier Communications, Michael E. Beardsley, 2610 W. Casino Rd, Everett, WA 98204 is the titled owner of two (2) 1999 Arctic Cat Bearcat snowmobiles, Serial Nos. 99017829 and 99017830, each with approximate mileage of 900 miles and an estimated value of approximately \$1,000; and

WHEREAS, Frontier Communications has offered to gift/donate the snowmobiles to Kootenai County for use by the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office personnel; and,

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office personnel could utilize the snowmobiles in its normal course of business in providing law enforcement and search and rescue services in Kootenai County;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that Kootenai County does hereby accept the gift/donation of the two (2) 1999 Arctic Cat Bearcat snowmobiles referenced hereinabove on behalf of the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the two (2) 1999 Arctic Bearcat snowmobiles be added to Kootenai County's list of assets as maintained by the Kootenai County Clerk/Auditor in its regular course of business.


Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Stewart, seconded by Commissioner Eberlein, the following vote was recorded:
