Adopt Kootenai County DOT Safety Sensitive Drug and Alcohol Policy

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners deems it necessary to adopt the Kootenai County DOT Safety Sensitive Drug and Alcohol Policy dated November 29, 2016, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Human Resources Director and Civil Prosecuting Attorney's office have adopted the Kootenai County DOT Safety Sensitive Drug and Alcohol Policy; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners approve the adoption of the Kootenai County DOT Safety Sensitive Drug and Alcohol Policy, effective November 29, 2016.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED wherein a Resolution previously passed is not in conformity with law or, in the alternative, inconsistent with this DOT Drug and Alcohol Policy that the DOT Drug and Alcohol Policy as passed shall supersede any previous Resolution which is not in conformity or in conflict with this document.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Stewart, seconded by Commissioner Eberlein, the following vote was recorded:


