

Resolution 2016-131
Acceptance of Donation of Aircraft Fuselage and Wings /Airport

WHEREAS, Chris Walsh is the owner of Beechcraft Bonanza, VIN 2736, which has an estimated value of \$10,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, Chris Walsh has agreed to gift/donate the Beechcraft Bonanza to the Kootenai County Airport for use by Airport staff for emergency training exercises; and,

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that Kootenai County does hereby accept the gift/donation of the Beechcraft Bonanza referenced hereinabove on behalf of the Kootenai County Airport.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Beechcraft Bonanza be added to Kootenai County's list of assets as maintained by the Kootenai County Clerk/Auditor in its regular course of business.


Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Stewart, seconded by Commissioner Eberlein, the following vote was recorded:


