

Resolution 2015-20
Surplus Property/Noxious Weeds

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and,

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Noxious Weeds Department has in its possession one (1) 1994 Chevrolet C1500 Cheyenne Pickup Truck, VIN No. 1GCEC14Z3RZ269596, Asset Tag No. 3429, valued at \$1,400.00, which due to age and condition is no longer cost-efficient to maintain; therefore, said vehicle is of no further use to the county; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Noxious Weed Department desires to have the above-referenced item declared as surplus property, and it is in the public interest to transfer/donate the above-described property to the North Idaho Fair and Rodeo;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the item referenced hereinabove be, and hereby is, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said item by public or private sale, or by another means, in accordance with Idaho law.
