

Resolution 2015-17
Surplus Property/Solid Waste

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and,

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County Solid Waste has on its asset list various items listed on attached "Exhibit A" which, due to age are inoperable and non-repairable; and

WHEREAS, due to their condition, these items were disposed of prior to the fixed asset inventory completed in 2014; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County Solid Waste has not notified other county departments regarding the availability of the above referenced items as they have been disposed of; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County Solid Waste desires to have the above referenced items removed from the County's asset list;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the items referenced hereinabove, are valueless, obsolete and disposed of and shall be removed from the County's list of assets.


Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Green, seconded by Commissioner Eberlein, the following vote was recorded:
