

Resolution 2015-25
Surplus Property/Recorder

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and,

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-808 provides that property classified as being valued under \$250.00 may be sold through a private sale without notice of public auction; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Recorder's Office has in its possession one (1) work counter, asset tag #3193 which, due to age is in disrepair; and

WHEREAS, the estimated total value of the property is less than \$250.00; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Recorder's Office desires to have the above referenced item declared as surplus property;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the item referenced hereinabove be, and hereby is, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said item by public or private sale, or by another means, in accordance with Idaho law.


Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Green, seconded by Commissioner Eberlein, the following vote was recorded:


