

Resolution No. 2015-36
Authorization to Return Found Money to Finder

WHEREAS, in December of 2013, Debra Hendricks found money in the amount of \$325.00 in a money bag at the Wal-Mart store located at 3050 E. Mullan Avenue in Post Falls; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Hendricks turned the money over to the Post Falls Police Department on December 21, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the procedure which must be followed when personal property valued at \$100.00 or more is found is set forth in section 55-405, Idaho Code; and

WHEREAS, after realizing that the procedure set forth in section 55-405, Idaho Code had not been followed, Detective Rod Gunderson of the Post Falls Police Department contacted the Kootenai County Clerk on January 28, 2014 to report the receipt of the found money, and caused the money to be turned over to the County; and

WHEREAS, upon receipt of notification from the County Clerk, the County Treasurer caused a legal notice to be placed in the *Coeur d'Alene Press* on February 24, 2014 and on March 3, 2014, pursuant to section 55-405, Idaho Code, at a cost to the County of \$77.87; and

WHEREAS, because no one other than the finder has come forward to make a claim to the money, it has been placed in the County general fund pursuant to section 55-405, Idaho Code; and

WHEREAS, the County Treasurer has made a request to the Board of County Commissioners to release the money, minus the amount expended for legal notice, to the finder; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the County Treasurer to remit funds in the amount of \$247.13 to Debra Hendricks, such amount being the amount found by Ms. Hendricks at the Wal-Mart store located at 3050 E. Mullan Avenue in Post Falls in December of 2013, minus the cost of legal notice incurred by the County.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Eberlein, seconded by Commissioner Stewart, the following vote was recorded:


