

**Resolution 2015-38
Surplus Van Cell/Jail/KCSO**

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and,

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Jail/Sheriff's Office is in possession of a van cell, asset tag #3933-5, Model No. EXT BASE/CELL removed from J-18, a 2006 Ford E-350 15 passenger van; and

WHEREAS, of May 2013, Ford no longer produces the E-series vans, and the vendor of the van cells is not producing a van cell for the new model vans, which have different dimensions; and

WHEREAS, the van cell is now obsolete and of no further use to the County; and

WHEREAS, the van cell described hereinabove has a value less than \$250.00; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Jail/Sheriff's Office desires to have the van cell declared as surplus property;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the item described hereinabove be, and hereby is, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said item by public or private sale, or by another means, in accordance with Idaho law.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Green, and seconded by Commissioner Eberlein, the following vote was recorded:


