

**Resolution 2015-40
Surplus Vehicle/Juvenile Probation**

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any person property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioner, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and,

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Juvenile Probation Department is in possession of a 2003 Chevrolet Astro Van, Asset Tag # 4037; VIN #1GNEL19X73B124916; Plate No. C10602, and

WHEREAS, due to age and wear, it would not be cost effective for Kootenai County to repair the vehicle should some major malfunction occur, and the sale of same would generate additional income for the County; and

WHEREAS, the vehicle described hereinabove has a value in excess of \$250.00; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County Juvenile Probation desires to have the vehicle declared as surplus property, and as such, to be disposed of by the County at public auction;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the vehicle described hereinabove be, and hereby is, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, said vehicle shall be sold a public auction to the highest bidder in accordance with *Idaho Code* §31-808.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Green, and seconded by Commissioner Eberlein, the following vote was recorded:


