

**Resolution 2015-79**  
**A Resolution Approving an Agreement with the**  
**National Joint Powers Alliance**

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County;

**WHEREAS**, the National Joint Powers Alliance (NJPA) is a Minnesota Service Cooperative enabled pursuant to Minnesota Statute § 123A.21 Subd. 7;

**WHEREAS**, the NJPA is permitted to enter into agreements with other governmental units in the United States to jointly or cooperatively exercise any power common to the contracting powers or similar powers, pursuant to Minnesota Statute §§ 471.345 Subd. 15, 471.59 Subd. 1, and 471.59 Subd. 10;

**WHEREAS**, Kootenai County is authorized to utilize contracts competitively solicited by another government unit pursuant to *Idaho Code* §§ 67-2328, and 67-2801, *et. seq.*; and,

**WHEREAS**, Kootenai County and the NJPA desire to enter into a "Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement" for the purpose of the County accessing available contracts for goods and services from the NJPA and its Awarded Vendors;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that Kootenai County, acting through its Board of Commissioners and representatives of the Kootenai County Airport, be and hereby are, authorized to enter into the attached "Joint Powers Agreement" with the NJPA, for all the above stated and other lawful purposes.


Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Stewart, seconded by Commissioner Eberlein, the following vote was recorded:


