

RESOLUTION 2014-01
Adoption of Official County Seal

WHEREAS, Idaho Statute 31-821 grants the power and duty to the Board of Commissioners to adopt a seal; and

WHEREAS, 2014 marks the sesquicentennial or 150th anniversary of the creation of Kootenai County; and

WHEREAS, we recognize the significance of the county's sesquicentennial and the adoption of an official seal is an integral part of this milestone and will address the need for cohesion in the county's identity; and

WHEREAS, it has been an ancient custom that official Seals be inscribed with designs symbolic or appropriate for the organization it represents; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County has never had an officially adopted seal and should have such a seal depicting the things for which our County is most noted and which we are proud of; and

WHEREAS, such a seal has been selected and designed by Jamie Kay Marble with a design which conceptually captures our history, our vision, and who we are as a county; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by this Kootenai County Commission that the design by Jamie Kay Marble is the Official Seal for Kootenai County, Idaho.

Upon a motion to adopt the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Nelson, seconded by Commissioner Green, the following vote was recorded:




