

Resolution 2014-11
Dissolution of Veterans Affairs Advisory Committee

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners received a request for the creation of a veterans advisory committee, for the purpose of providing support and representation for veterans in Kootenai County; and,

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Veterans Council voted to support the creation of such a committee; and

WHEREAS, on March 7, 2006, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners, created under the authority of Idaho Code 31-828 and 65-601, a Kootenai County advisory Committee known as the "Kootenai County Veterans Affairs Committee" including bylaws governing the appointment and terms of the members; and

WHEREAS, no action was subsequently taken to form such a committee;



Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Green, seconded by Commissioner Nelson, the following vote was recorded:


Commissioner Nelson: Aye


