

Resolution 2014-37A
Ratification of Title III Funds Request
Proposal for Reimbursement of Funds/Kootenai County Search & Rescue

WHEREAS, a request for reimbursement for search and rescue services along with emergency services provided by the Sheriff's Department on National Forest lands between January 1, 2004 and December 31, 2006 was submitted to the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners, and

WHEREAS, Public Law 106-393, the Secure Rural Schools and Community Self-Determination Act of 2000 was enacted in part to stabilize payments to counties and compensate for the decrease in federal timber sales and shared revenues; and

WHEREAS, a Notice of 45-day Comment Period was published in the Coeur d' Alene Press on May 11, 2014 and May 28, 2014 with the comment period ending May 27, 2014; and

WHEREAS, on April 29, 2014 the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners signed Resolution 2014-37 approving funds in the amount of \$64,973.70 once the comment period was completed,



Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Nelson, seconded by Commissioner Green, the following roll was recorded:


