

Resolution 2014-66
Surplus Property/Assessor

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and,

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Assessor has on its asset list (1) Geoline Laser Impulse (model #Impulse 200LR/Serial #H21-C7003824, Asset #3322), which due to age is obsolete and of no further use to the county and was disposed of by a former employee; and

WHEREAS, the estimated present value of the equipment is less than \$250.00: it is obsolete and essentially valueless and,

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Assessor has not notified other county departments regarding the availability of the above referenced item as it's whereabouts are unknown and the item is obsolete; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Assessor desires to have the above-referenced item removed from the County's asset list;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the item referenced hereinabove is valueless, obsolete, disposed of and shall be removed from the County's list of assets.


Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Green, seconded by Commissioner Nelson, the following vote was recorded:




