

Resolution 2014-90
Surplus Equipment – Prosecuting Attorney’s Office

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and,

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belong to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Prosecuting Attorney’s Office has on its asset list one (1) OCE Copier, Model No. IM4512, Serial Number 8050101000, Asset Tag 4674 which is obsolete and of no further use to the County and has been replaced; and

WHEREAS, the estimated present value of the copier is less than \$250.00, specifically, the copier has zero value; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Prosecuting Attorney’s Office has not notified other county departments regarding the availability of this item as it has been returned to OCE and scrapped as part of a complimentary service provided by said manufacturer; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Prosecuting Attorney’s Office desires to have the above referenced items removed from the County’s asset list;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the item referenced hereinabove is valueless, obsolete and shall be removed from the County’s list of assets.


