The following Resolution was introduced by Commissioner Green, read in full, considered and adopted:

Resolution number 2014-85 of Kootenai County, Idaho accepting the Grant Offer of the State of Idaho through the Idaho Transportation Department, Division of Aeronautics, in the maximum amount of \$7,977 to be used under the Idaho Airport Aid Program, Program number: F158COE, Project number: AIP-041 in the development of the Coeur d'Alene - Pappy Boyington Field Airport; and

Be it resolved by the Chairman and County Commission of Kootenai County, Idaho (herein referred to as the "County") as follows:

Sec. 1. That the County shall accept the Grant Offer of the State of Idaho in the amount of \$7,977, for the purpose of obtaining State Aid under Program Number: F158COE, Project Number: AIP-041 in the development of the Coeur d'Alene - Pappy Boyington Field Airport; and

Sec. 2. That the Chairman of the Kootenai County is hereby authorized and directed to sign the statement of Acceptance of said Grant Offer (entitled Acceptance) on behalf of the County. The County Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to attest the signature of the Chairman and to impress the official seal of the County on the aforesaid statement of Acceptance; and

Sec. 3. A true copy of the Grant Agreement referred to herein be attached hereto and made a part thereof.



