

**Resolution 2014-96
Surplus Vehicle/Bailiff/District Court**

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and,

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County District Court/Bailiff's Office is in possession of a 1989 Chevy Blazer, VIN No. 1GNCT18Z1K0141215, Plate #C16208 and;

WHEREAS, it would not be cost effective for Kootenai County to repair the vehicle should some major malfunction occur and the sale of same would generate additional income for the County; and

WHEREAS, the vehicle described hereinabove has a value in excess of \$250.00; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County District Court/Bailiff's Office desires to have the vehicle declared as surplus property, and as such to be disposed of by the County at public auction;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the vehicle described hereinabove be, and hereby is, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, said vehicle shall be sold at public auction to the highest bidder in accordance with *Idaho Code* §31-808.


