

Resolution 2013-03
Surplus Equipment/1994 Peterbuilt Tractor Truck/Solid Waste

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Solid Waste Department has in its possession a 1994 Peterbuilt Tractor Truck, VIN 1XPCDB9X5RD363606 which due to age is of no further use to the County; and the sale of the same would generate additional income for the Department; and,

WHEREAS, the vehicle described hereinabove has a value in excess of \$250; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Solid Waste Department desires to have the vehicle declared as surplus property, and as such, to be disposed of by the County at public auction.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the vehicle described hereinabove be, and hereby is, declared to be surplus property, and, in accordance therewith, said vehicle shall be sold at public auction to the highest bidder, and if not sold at said public auction, then said vehicle may be disposed of through private sale or other means in accordance with *Idaho Code* § 31-808.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Green, seconded by Commissioner Nelson, the following vote was recorded:
