

Resolution 2013-37
Surplus/Trade-in of Personal Property/Vehicles
Adult Misdemeanor Probation

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment is obsolete, worn or damaged so as to require replacement, and is of greater value as a trade-in or exchange for replacement than upon sale, he/she may, incident to purchase of such replacement and with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, trade-in or exchange such personal property and apply its trade-in or exchange value on the purchase price of a replacement; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County Adult Misdemeanor Probation has two (2) motor vehicles in its possession which have been utilized by the department for field work, to-wit:

1997 Pontiac Grand Prix, VIN No. 1G2WJ52K6VF217581
2000 Chevrolet Malibu, VIN No. 1G1NE52JOY6131960

The 1997 Pontiac Grand Prix has an odometer reading of 100,000 miles, and the 2000 Chevrolet Malibu has an odometer reading of 140,000 miles; and

WHEREAS, the two (2) vehicles referenced hereinabove have outlived their usefulness to the Adult Misdemeanor Probation Department due to high mileage and escalating costs for upkeep and repair in order to maintain the vehicles in a safe, reliable, and useful condition; and,

WHEREAS, the 1997 Pontiac Grand Prix has a present estimated wholesale value of \$1,000.00 and the 2000 Chevrolet Malibu has a present estimated wholesale value of \$1,500.00; and,

WHEREAS, Adult Misdemeanor Probation desires to use the two (2) vehicles hereinabove described as trade-in vehicles for the purchase of a new vehicle to service its department, in that such vehicles have a greater value on trade-in than upon sale; and,

WHEREAS, Adult Misdemeanor Probation seeks the consent of the Kootenai County Board of County Commissioners before taking action to trade-in the two (2) vehicles described hereinabove; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners consent to the trade-in of the two (2) vehicles referenced hereinabove;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that Adult Misdemeanor Probation is hereby authorized to use the two (2) vehicles referenced hereinabove as trade-in property for the purchase of a replacement vehicle to service its department.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Nelson, seconded by Commissioner Green, the following vote was recorded:
