

**RESOLUTION NO. 2013-42**  
**Destroy Records/Use of Force Administrative Reports/KCSO**

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* § 31-871 states that county records may only be destroyed by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners; and,

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* § 31-871 requires the resolution ordering destruction and disposition of county records to list, in detail, records to be destroyed; and,

**WHEREAS**, an audit of certain county records in the possession of the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office having been performed and legal advice having been sought and given regarding the disposal of said records.

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the Use of Force Administrative Reports previously classified as temporary records by Resolution No. 2013-41 have surpassed the statutory retention period as public records and therefore may be destroyed.

**BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED** that the destruction and disposition of the Use of Force Administrative Reports identified in Resolution No. 2013-41 shall be done under the direction and supervision of the Clerk of the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners.
