

RESOLUTION NO. 2013-102
Destroy Records/Jail Medical Files/KCSO

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* § 31-871 states that county records may only be destroyed by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners; and,

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* § 31-871 requires the resolution ordering destruction and disposition of county records to list, in detail, records to be destroyed; and,

WHEREAS, an audit of certain county records in the possession of the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office, Jail Division, having been performed and legal advice having been sought and given regarding the disposal of said records.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the inmate medical files previously classified as permanent records by Resolution No. 2013-101, as attached thereto as Exhibit "A," have surpassed the statutory retention period as public records and therefore may be destroyed.



Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Green, and seconded by Commissioner Nelson, the following vote was recorded:


