

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-67

**Termination of Resolution No. 2025-52,
Disaster Declaration, Kootenai County Active Shooter and Wildfire, Canfield
Mountain
September 2, 2025**

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §46-1011- LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCIES provides that a local disaster emergency may be declared by chairman of the county commissioners to activate the response and recovery aspects of any and all local or intergovernmental disaster emergency plans and to authorize the furnishing of aid thereunder; and

WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners declared a local disaster emergency on June 29, 2025, in response to a large-scale wildfire and simultaneous active shooter event, and the Board of County Commissioners thereafter ratified Resolution No. 2025-52; and

WHEREAS, the June 29, 2025, wildfire and active shooter event at issue in Resolution No. 2025-52, are no longer creating an imminent threat to human life, structures, infrastructures, public utilities, and private and public property within Kootenai County; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County is no longer requesting assistance from any other agency pursuant to Resolution No. 2025-52; and

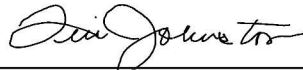
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and declared by the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners, pursuant to the authority granted in Section 46-1011, Idaho Code, as follows:

1. A disaster emergency no longer exists within Kootenai County.
2. This Resolution terminates Resolution No. 2025-52.
