

Resolution 2025-78
Surplus Vehicles/Assessor

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §31-808 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgement, is of no further use to the county; he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and,

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Assessor's Office is in the possession of the following vehicle:

One (1) 2002 Chevrolet Blazer, Asset #3853, VIN 1GNDDT13WX2K161842 and

WHEREAS, the vehicle described hereinabove have a value in excess of \$250.00; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Assessor's Office desires to have the vehicle declared as surplus property, as the 2002 Chevrolet Blazer is 23 years old, having recurring mechanical issues resulting in unanticipated expenses; and

WHEREAS, the sale of this vehicle would generate additional income for the County; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Assessor's Office desires to have the vehicle declared as surplus property, and as such to be disposed of by the County at public auction;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the vehicle described hereinabove be and hereby are declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, said vehicles shall be sold at public auction to the highest bidder, after advertising the same as surplus property in accordance with *Idaho Code* §31-808.
