

Where do you live?




Do you interact with Historic Preservation in your business or profession


Are you in real estate, architecture, or building/construction?


Do you live in or own a historic property (over 50 years old)?


How familiar are you with listing a historic property on a local, state, or national registry/inventory?


Do you have a general interest in history or Historic Preservation?


Which of the following items do you feel benefit from Historic Preservation? (Select all that apply.)


How familiar are you with the historic resources in Kootenai County? (Please consider buildings, sites, and objects around 50 years of age or older.)


How familiar are you with Kootenai County's historical markers? (Examples: Pen d'Oreille City, The Mullan Tree/Road, Lake Steamers, etc.)


How do you feel the preservation of historic places and resources is viewed in your community? (Select all that apply.)


Agree or Disagree: There are adequate programs throughout Kootenai County and its cities to promote and/or educate residents and visitors about the County's history.


Which of these historical museums have you visited in Kootenai County? (Select all that apply.)


Why do you think it's important to preserve Kootenai County's heritage? (Select all that apply.)
