**ASSIGNMENT OF CASES TO
JUDGES OF THE MAGISTRATE DIVISION**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the order entered June 5, 1990 and amended on December 8, 1992 designating jurisdiction of Judges of the Magistrate Division, be and hereby is further amended as follows:

All Judges of the Magistrate Division of the District Court of the First Judicial District are hereby assigned to hear all proceedings as are designated in Idaho Code Sections 1-2208 and 1-2210 in accordance with Rule 82 of the Idaho Rules of Civil Procedure, which shall include:

All civil proceedings in which the amount of money or damages or the value of the property does not exceed \$10,000.00, including without limitation:

Hearings on orders to show cause, issuance of restraining orders, temporary injunctions, and injunctions incidental thereto;

Actions for the recovery of money only arising on contracts express or implied: actions for damages for injury to person, property or reputation or for taking or detaining personal property, and for fraud;

Actions for rent and distress for rent;

Actions for claim and delivery;

Proceedings in attachment, garnishment, wage deductions for the benefit of creditors, trial or right of personal property and exemptions, and supplementary proceedings;

Actions arising under the laws for the incorporation of cities or counties or any ordinance passed in pursuance thereof; actions for the confiscation or abatement of nuisances and the seizure, condemnation and forfeiture of personal property; proceedings in respect of estrays and lost property;

Actions to collect taxes;

Proceedings in forcible entry, forcible detainer, and unlawful detainer;

Proceedings for the enforcement and foreclosure of common law and statutory liens on real or personal property:

Proceedings in the probate of wills and administration of estates of decedents, minors and incompetents;

All proceedings involving the custody of minors and all habeas corpus proceedings;

All proceedings for divorce, separate maintenance or annulment;

Proceedings in quo warranto, or for injunction prohibition, mandamus, ne exeat, or appointment of a receiver;

BAC refusal proceedings;

Domestic violence crime prevention act proceedings;

Proceedings under the Uniform Reciprocal Enforcement of Support Act and Idaho Code Section 32-710A;

Proceedings for the termination of parent/child relationships;

Proceedings for adoption;

Proceedings to establish paternity; and

Proceedings for change of name.

The following criminal and quasi-criminal proceedings:

Proceedings for the appointment of counsel in all criminal proceedings or probation violations.

Misdemeanor and quasi-criminal actions;

Proceedings to prevent the commission of crimes;

Proceedings pertaining to warrants for arrest or for searches and seizures;

Proceedings regarding Infractions; and, Proceedings for the preliminary examination (preliminary hearings) to determine probable cause, commitment prior to trial or the release on bail and the acceptance of guilty pleas of persons charged with felony criminal offenses.

All proceedings within the scope of the Juvenile Justice Act and Child Protective Act.


All proceedings relating to the hospitalization of the mentally ill pursuant to Title 66, Chapter 3 of the Idaho Code.


All proceedings relating to the care of the developmentally disabled pursuant to Title 66, Chapter 4 of the Idaho Code.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in those counties where there is not a resident district judge or the resident district judge is absent, the Judges of the Magistrate Division are authorized in all civil actions regardless of the nature of the action or the dollar value of any claim to enter orders authorizing the service of summonses pursuant to Idaho Code Section 5-508 and to enter defaults and default judgments pursuant to I.R.C.P. 55.




