

Resolution 2026-____
Designate Title VI Compliance Officer

WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States has passed Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 42 U.S.C. § 2000d *et seq.* (Title VI), which provides that no person shall, on the ground of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving federal financial assistance; and,

WHEREAS, Kootenai County, as a recipient of federal and state funding, is required to comply with Title VI; and,

WHEREAS, Kootenai County is committed to compliance with Title VI; and,

WHEREAS, it is the duty of the Kootenai County Board of County Commissioners to appoint a responsible employee to act as the Title VI Compliance Officer for the County, to oversee the affairs of the County and assure that all County programs, policies, procedures, and facilities are accessible to, and useable by, all persons in a manner which does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, or national origin, and are in compliance with the provisions of Title VI;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners does appoint Chad Ingle as the Title VI Compliance Officer for Kootenai County in accordance with the requirements of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
