

**Resolution 2026-28**  
**Surplus Equipment/Asset Deletion/Prosecuting Attorney**

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-808 provides that property valued at less than \$250.00 may be sold through a private sale without notice of public auction; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai County Prosecuting Attorney's office is in possession of the following item, which is obsolete, not usable, and, due to age, is unrepairable, fully depreciated, and has outlived its usefulness to the County:

One (1) Offender Watch Software, Asset #6261, Watch Systems, Offender Watch

**WHEREAS**, the item of equipment described hereinabove is valued at less than \$250.00, and

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai County Prosecuting Attorney's Office desires to have the item of equipment identified hereinabove declared as surplus property, deleted from its asset list, and disposed of pursuant to law;

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the item referenced hereinabove be, and hereby are, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said item in accordance with Idaho law and remove the same from the County's list of assets.
