## NOXIOUS WEED ALERT

Noxious weeds are not native to Idaho; they crowd out native plants, thus upsetting the balance of nature. Weeds cost millions of dollars to control in our area. They degrade wildlife habitat, choke streams and waterways, crowd out beneficial native plants, create fire hazards in forests and on our ranges, create greater erosion risks, poison and injure livestock and humans, and foul recreation sites.

**Idaho State law places the responsibility of noxious weed control on the landowner (Idaho Code 22-2407).**

There are 67 weed species and 4 genera designated as noxious by state law, plus 2 designated by Kootenai County.

Noxious weeds typically found in Kootenai County include:

- spotted & diffuse knapweed
- leafy spurge
- Canada thistle
- meadow & orange hawkweed
- yellow & Dalmatian toadflax
- rush skeletonweed
- purple loosestrife
- Scotch broom
- poison hemlock
- hoary cress
- field bindweed
- oxeye daisy
- Japanese, Bohemian and giant knotweeds
- viper's bugloss (blueweed)



★\$50 Reward offered for new sightings of these weeds! ★ dyers woad, ★ musk thistle, ★puncture vine, ★ Scotch thistle, ★ tansy ragwort, ★ yellow starthistle.

As soon as these weeds are found, we want them eradicated and to keep a close check on the site in the future. If you have seen one of these, call and tell us where you saw the plant(s) so we can collect, eradicate, and contain the infestation. If the site is a new one, you can collect a \$50 reward for being the first to report it – please give us your name and address so we can send you a check.

New weeds we want to know about when you find them: kochia, common bugloss, small bugloss, Eurasian watermilfoil, and plumeless thistle.
